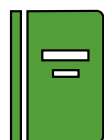


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Setting our next goals!

Toolkit on Climate Change translated in all partner countries



Under the ECO-MEDIA project, a toolkit was developed for youth work and young engagement in the scope of climate change as a resource designed to support individuals and organizations working with young people to address climate change and foster sustainable practices. The toolkit will be open and accessible to all through the project's platform and is available in English, Italian, Greek and Spanish languages.

Development of training units for Youth



Nine training units have been developed and will be pilot tested to be uploaded to the e-learning platform. The thematic areas covered by the nine training units include the following: social media activism; engagement of young people in climate change and environmental challenges; becoming a better youth worker/trainer/mentor; active citizenship; digital activism; community media for social responsibility; digital activism; E-volunteering for social challenges; European opportunities for e-volunteering; networking.
